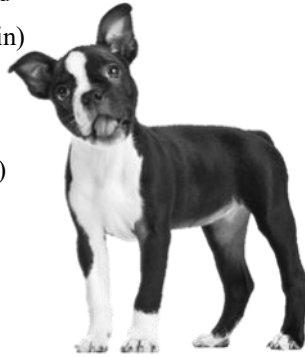


Our recommendations for the happiness of your dog

Food

- Interactive bowl or stainless-steel/ceramic bowl for food
- Water bowl or fountain (+ replacement filter for fountain)
- Ceramic or stainless-steel bowl for canned food
- Quality dry or raw food and canned food
- Complementary foods (dehydrated, freeze-dried or raw)
- Cookies and sticks for inserting into toys
- Plastic or silicone can cover



Cleanliness and education

- Crate (rest and training)
- Feces/urine odor eliminator
- Very tasty and friable treats for training
- Pouch for treats
- Noisy toy (recall training, reward, master and dog play, dog fun)
- Kindergarten and/or obedience classes
- Waste shovel
- 6' thin leash (indoor training)
- 15' or more lanyard (outdoor training)
- Training pad + puppy trainer (if potty trained inside)
- Doorbell for potty training
- Clicker
- Annual check-up at the veterinarian

Maintenance and care

- Brush, comb, Furminator, dematting comb (depending on our type)
- Dog toothbrush and toothpaste, tartar controler
- Claw clippers, styptic powder and diamond claws file (claw clipping recommended every 5 weeks)
- Eye cleaner (dogs with protruding eyes or long facial hair) and tear stain remover powder
- Ear cleaner
- Shampoo, coat conditioner (for long coat), dry shampoo and coat spritzer
- Supplement for coat
- Flea control (12 weeks older, 3 seasons per year)
- Probiotics (perfect for period of stress, diarrhea, post treatment or food changes)
- Adaptil (anxiety relief)

Rest

- Dog playpen (useful indoors or outdoors)
- Cushion and/or blanket
- Cushion / mat for crate (after teenage period)
- Cuddly toy as « buddy » (always under supervision)

Play and activities

We recommend having several sets of toys and bones, in order to rotate and thus maintain the dog's interest and a good level of activity.

- Variety of chewable bones (marrowbone, rawhide, raw bones, dental bones, natural sticks, etc.)
- Interactive toys
- Minimum 3 safe toys for crate including one to hide treats
 - Solid toys for chewing
 - Nylon bones (TPR)
 - Toy « Kong » type
 - Toys where you can hide treats (various types)
 - Rubber toys (various textures, shapes and densities)
- Minimum 3 toys for fun with different textures and sizes (under supervision)
 - Rope toy
 - Ball (squeak or not)
 - Outside ball
 - Frisbee and/or launcher
 - Squeak toys
 - Plush toys (various shapes and textures)
 - Dimpled Ball to insert other toys or bones

Walking

- Personalized medal and SPA license
- Flat collar and 6' leash or multifunction leash
- Harness or head collar (Quebec law for dogs over 40 pounds)
- Poop bags and dispenser pouches
- Tie-out cable/tie rod for outdoor
- Car harness or Carrier (highway safety code)
- Travel water bottle or bowl
- Car seat cover
- Boots, raincoat and winter coat
